INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES FOR SPORTS

122 SHRI HARBHAJAN SINGH:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether sports facilities like national level trainer, appointment of coaches and other modern facilities are available in all the States/Districts of the country for providing training to youth to prepare them for various sports competitions including national/ international level competitions;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State/ UT-wise;

(c) whether the youth from the State of Punjab are getting all the facilities for preparation of sports at national level and if so, the details thereof and if not the reasons therefor; and

(d) the details of funds spent for this purpose during the last three years, State/UT-wise?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF THE RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 122 FOR 28.07.2022 REGARDING INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES FOR SPORTS ASKED BY SHRI HARBHAJAN SINGH.

(a) and (b): Sports being a State subject, the primary responsibility for development and promotion of sports rests with the respective State/UT Government. This Ministry supplements the efforts of the State/UT Governments through its various sports promotional schemes. A total of 189 Centres including National Centres of Excellence (NCOEs), (SAI Training Centres) STCs, Extension Centres, etc. are functional across the country for implementation of the sports promotional schemes. The State-wise details of these schemes are provided at **Annexure – I**.

Presently, 8119 talented sports persons (4973 boys and 3146 girls) are being trained in 28 sports disciplines on residential and non-residential basis. The selected athletes are provided financial support in the form of expert coaches, sports equipment, scientific support, boarding and lodging, sports kit, competition exposure, educational expenses, medical/ insurance and stipend as per the approved scheme norms. A total of 966 Coaches have been appointed by the Ministry under various Sports Promotional Schemes. The State/UT-wise details of Coaches deployed are provided at **Annexure – II**.

Further, under Talent Search Development component of Khelo India, an athlete selected as a Khelo India Athlete (KIA) is entitled for Out of Pocket Allowance (OPA) of ₹ 1,20,000 per annum for meeting day to day expenses, including training. Additionally, an athlete is also entitled for ₹ 5,00,000/- per annum for training purposes including funding for sports equipment, coaching, boarding, lodging, sports kit and other modern facilities if they opt to be trained in an Accredited Academy.

Under the Khelo India Centre (KIC) component, funds are released to each KIC at the rate of ₹5 lakh per annum for the procurement of Sports Equipment, Coaches (Past Champion Athletes) and each Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE) is eligible for support for coaches and equipment based on viability gap analysis conducted jointly with the respective State Governments. The State/UT- wise details of Khelo India Centres (KIC), Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE) and Accredited Academies are provided at **Annexure – III**.

Also, under the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS), the Ministry provides assistance and customized training to India's top athletes in their preparations for Olympic and Paralympic Games. Out-of-pocket allowance of ₹ 50,000/- per month is given to the TOPS Core Group athletes and ₹ 25,000/- per month to the TOPS Development Group athletes.

Besides, under the component "Utilization and Creation of Sports Infrastructure" of the Khelo India Scheme, 300 sports infrastructure projects of various types have been sanctioned across the country. The State-wise details of the projects are at **Annexure-IV**.

(c): The Sports Promotional Schemes of the Department are implemented across all the States/UTs including the State of Punjab. Under the Khelo India Scheme, 11 sports infrastructure projects of various types have been sanctioned in Punjab. The details of these projects are at **Annexure-V**.
