GST DAY CELEBRATION

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government had recently celebrated 5th GST Day with a theme of “Saadhan, Desh ke Sarvangeen Vikas ka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, and the programmes organized to commemorate this occasion; and;
- (c) whether it is a fact that a steady increase in GST collection has been recorded during the last one year, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The 5th GST day was celebrated at national level at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on 01.07.2022 with a theme of “Saadhan, Desh ke Sarvangeen Vikas Ka”.

The programme organized to commemorate this occasion included five thematic presentations by representatives of industry on-

- (i) impact of GST on inter-state trade,
- (ii) impact of GST on MSME sector,
- (iii) impact of GST on export,
- (iv) procedural simplification under GST, and
- (v) digitization & formalization under GST.

Further, a short film on GST, release of booklet “GST@5” and presentation of Commendation certificates to taxpayers and officers of CBIC were also conducted. In addition, all field offices of CGST zones under CBIC celebrated the GST Day in their respective zones.

(c)The monthly average gross GST Collection in FY 2021-22 was Rs. 1,23,608 Crores. The details of month-wise GST collection during the FY 2021-22 are as under:-
