'ONE NATION, ONE DIALYSIS' PROGRAMME

1062. SHRI BRIJLAL:

Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has launched or proposes to launch 'One Nation, One Dialysis' programme under the Prime Minister National Dialysis Programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the salient features of the said programme;
- (c) the details of the eligible persons who can avail the benefits of the 'One Nation, One Dialysis' programme; and
- (d) the details of the parts of the country where the said programme has been launched, so far, location-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Under the Prime Minister National Dialysis Programme(PMNDP), an IT portal has been developed for integrating all existing dialysis facilities under National Health Mission (NHM). This Portal facilitates portability for the patients in availing dialysis services from one place to another place.

Also, under PMNDP, dialysis services are provided free of cost to all Below Poverty Line (BPL) beneficiaries at the public health facilities supported under NHM. PMNDP has two components namely Hemodialysis (HD) and Peritoneal Dialysis (PD) services, provided through in-house or public private partnership/hybrid mode to the beneficiaries. PMNDP is operational in 36 States/UTs in 603 districts at 1121 dialysis centres by deploying 7721 haemodialysis machines as on 31st May 2022.
