VACANCIES IN CENTRAL GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of number of sanctioned posts of teaching and non-teaching staffs in various primary and secondary schools of Central Government;
- (b) the details of vacancies of teaching and non-teaching staffs as on 30th June, 2022 in various primary and secondary schools of Central Government; and
- (c) the details of vacancies of teaching and non-teaching staffs in various schools, advertised and filled up during 2020, 2021 and 2022, year-wise?

(a) & (b) Central Government Schools namely Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) are under the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education and fully funded by the Government of India. The details of vacancies against the sanctioned teaching and non-teaching posts in KVs and JNVs as on 30.06.2022 are as under:-

*JNVs are fully residential schools from classes VI to XII and there are no primary classes.

- (c) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has informed that due to prevailing COVID-19 pandemic no recruitment has been made in 2020, 2021 and 2022 (till date).

Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS) has informed that candidate have been selected in respect of 471 teaching posts in the year 2020 and 1939 teaching posts and 94 non-teaching posts in the year 2021 against the vacancy notified in July, 2019. Further, 2887 vacancies of teaching posts and 2572 vacancies of Non-teaching posts have been notified by NVS in July, 2022 and January, 2022 respectively.
