(a): In the State of Odisha, as per Udyam Portal the number of registered Micro, Small and Medium enterprises as on 13.07.2022 are-

The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) implement various schemes for the growth and development of MSME sector in the country including the State of Odisha.

(b): Digital initiatives by the Ministry of MSMEs include online registration by MSMEs on Udyam portal, online receipt and disposal of grievances of MSMEs through Champions portal, online monitoring of Delayed Payments of MSMEs through Samadhan portal. These initiatives have benefitted MSMEs of the country including the State of Odisha.

(c): The Ministry of MSME has established Technology Centre (TC) at Bhubneswar, which provides technological support to industries through design & manufacture of tools, precision components, moulds, dies etc. The Ministry also implements various schemes and programmes for the growth and development of MSME sector. These schemes / programmes include Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Procurement and marketing support to MSMEs, ECLGS, and Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI).
