STOPPAGE OF PATNA RAJDHANI AT BUXAR

1585 SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes for stoppage of 12309/12310 Patna Rajdhani at Buxar station for at least two minutes to facilitate passengers of Buxar, Ballia, Ghazipur, Aarah districts etc;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of representations received from Members of Parliament in this regard; and
- (e) the details of action taken thereon, representation-wise?

(a) to (c) Rajdhani Express services are premium services running to tight schedule and with limited stoppages enroute. Proliferation of stoppage enroute is operationally not expedient. As such, presently, there is no proposal for provision of stoppage of 12309/12310 Rajendra Nagar (T) - New Delhi Rajdhani Express at Buxar.

(d) and (e) Request for introduction of a new Rajdhani Express service between Danapur and New Delhi, with stoppage at Buxar, has been received. The same has been examined but not found feasible for implementation, at present, due to operational and resource constraints.
