EXPENDITURE ON HEALTH

1867: DR. V. SIVADASAN:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the total budgeted expenditure on Health spent by the Union and States altogether in the last five years, year-wise;
- (b) if so, the percentage borne by the Union Government;
- (c) the percentage of 'out of pocket' medical expenditure made by a patient, State-wise, year-wise, since last five years;
- (d) the number of Panchayats or Municipalities that do not have Primary Health Centres (PHCs), State-wise; and
- (e) the list of Panchayats or Municipalities that do not have PHCs and the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) As per the National Health Account Estimates, the Government Health Expenditure (GHE), along with share of Union and State Government in GHE are as follows:

(d) & (e): Under the National Health Mission (NHM), Primary Health Centre (PHC) are established to cover a population of 30,000 in rural areas and 20,000 in hilly, tribal and desert areas. As per Rural Health Statistics (RHS) 2020-21, the 30,579 PHCs are functional. The State-wise number of PHCs in rural and urban areas is at **Annexure-I**.
