CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) SPENDING

QUESTION

194. SHRI JOHN BRITTAS:

Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and quantum of amount spent by companies under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) during the last three years, year-wise and State-wise;
- (b) whether Government closely monitors that every concerned company in the country is promptly fulfilling its CSR responsibilities; and
- (c) if so, the details of tools being relied by Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The broad framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been provided under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Schedule VII of the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. Under the Act, CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities based on the recommendations of its CSR Committee. The CSR framework is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry is available in public domain and can be accessed at www.csr.gov.in. The Government monitors the compliance of CSR provisions through the disclosures made by the companies in the MCA 21 registry. Whenever any violation of CSR provisions is reported, action against such non-compliant Companies is initiated as per provisions of the Act after due examination of records and following due process of law.

On the basis of the filings made by companies in the MCA 21 registry, CSR spent by the companies during the last three Financial Years from FY 2018-19 to FY 2020-21 is given below:
