Development of educational facilities in Odisha

1942 **Dr. Sasmit Patra:**

Will the Minister of **EDUCATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of development of educational facilities in Odisha by Central and the State Government;
- (b) total expenditure incurred by Central Government and the State Government towards the development of educational facilities in Odisha during the last five years;
- (c) total expenditure incurred by the State Government towards the development of educational facilities in Odisha during the last five years; and
- (d) future plans in this regard by Central Government and the State Government?

(a) to (d): Education is in the concurrent list of the Constitution and majority of the schools are under domain of respective State and UT Government. Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education is implementing a centrally sponsored Integrated Scheme for School Education 'Samagra Shiksha', effective from 2018-19, by subsuming the schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), and Teacher Education (TE), for universalization of quality education throughout the country in coordination with the States and UTs. The fund sharing pattern for the scheme between Centre and State is in the ratio of 60:40 for the State of Odisha.

Under Samagra Shiksha, support is provided for creation of educational facilities such as opening of new schools/Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose (NSCB) residential schools & Hostels/Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs), up-gradation of existing schools, strengthening of physical infrastructure in schools and for introduction of vocational education in schools etc. The details of these facilities in the State of Odisha is given at Annexure-I.

For implementation of the scheme, the annual plans are prepared by the States and UTs based on their requirements and priority and this is reflected in their respective Annual Work Plan and Budget Proposals. These plans are then appraised and approved/estimated by the Project Approval Board in the

DoSEL in consultation with the States and UTs as per the programmatic and financial norms of the scheme. Since the inception of Samgra Shiksha, the details of expenditure in the State of Odisha is as under:

In addition, as on 31.07.2022, 66 Kendriya Vidyalayas and 31 Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas are functional in the State of Odisha.

Further, for Higher Education, one Indian Institute of Technology, Bhubaneswar, one Indian Institute of Management in Sambalpur and one National Institute of Technology, Rourekla are functioning in the State of Odisha.
