DEVELOPMENT OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS IN ODISHA

- (a) the details of National Highways and State Highways in Odisha in terms of length, location, etc.;
- (b) the total expenditure incurred by Centre and the State towards the development of road transport and highways in Odisha; and
- (c) future plans in this regard by the Centre and the State?

(a) Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRT&H) is primarily responsible for development & maintenance of National Highways apart from looking after the works on state roads under Central Road & Infrastructure Fund (CRIF). The details of National Highways in Odisha are at Annexure-I.

(b) Expenditure incurred on NH works and CRIF works in the State of Odisha during the last three years are as under:

(c) Development of National Highways such as capacity upgradation, repair/rehabilitation/reconstruction of existing pavement, bridges, culverts & structures, construction of Road Over Bridges/Road Under Bridges/underpasses/flyovers, installation of safety measures, etc. is a continuous process and such works are taken up depending upon traffic demand, existing condition, safety threats to traffic, interse priority, etc.
