SCHEMES FOR THE WELFARE OF STREET VENDORS

2506. DR. K. LAXMAN:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of schemes meant for the street vendors under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), the details thereof;
- (b) the number of vendors registered through Udyam from Telangana to avail the benefits under MSMEs, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of fund allocated to Telangana Government by the Central Government for the welfare of street vendors?

(a) & (b): As informed by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), as a part of Aatma Nirbhar Bharat package, MoHUA is implementing Central Sector Scheme, PM Street Vendor's AtmaNirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi) Scheme since June 01, 2020, to facilitate collateral free working capital loan, to street vendors to restart their businesses adversely impacted due to Covid- 19 pandemic. The 1st loan is upto Rs. 10,000 with a term of 12 months followed by 2nd loan of upto Rs. 20,000 with a term of 18 months and 3rd loan of upto Rs. 50,000 with a term of 36 months, on repayment of the earlier loans. As on 25.07.2022, 53.95 lakh loan applications have been received, out of which 37.24 lakh loan applications have been sanctioned and 33.79 lakh loans amounting to Rs. 3692 Cr. have been disbursed to the street vendors. The total number of MSMEs registered on Udyam in Telangana under NIC codes 45 and 47 is 28,815, which includes street vendors.

(c): As informed by MoHUA, PM SVANidhi is a Central Sector Scheme. No funds are allocated to States for disbursement to beneficiaries. Loan amount is directly released to the beneficiaries by the Lending Institutions
