Export of petroleum products

2540. Shri Brijlal:

Will the Minister of **Petroleum and Natural Gas** be pleased to state :

- (a) whether the export of petroleum products from India to Europe is likely to increase due to the ongoing gas supply dispute between Russia and Europe, if so, the details thereof ;
- (b) the revenue likely to be generated through this scenario to the country; and
- (c) the steps taken by Government to meet this increased demand?

(a) to (c): Oil Companies after meeting the domestic demand, export surplus production of petroleum products through tendering. Surplus petroleum products are sold to registered vendors. The contracts in this regard are not destination specific.

Export of petroleum products by Indian refiners (quantity as well as value) varies from year to year as shown below on account of various factors such as local demand supply scenario, international prices, price bids received, seasonality, refinery shut down etc. :-
