- (b) the total number of students from Delhi and Punjab who have received any Government funded assistance to pursue courses abroad since financial year 2019-20;
- (c) the details of steps taken by Government to introduce new fellowships for meritorious Indian students to study abroad; and
- (d) the list and details of the fellowships offered to Indian students with Government collaboration?

(a) to (d): The Ministry of Education provides assistance including financial aid to Indian students for higher studies in India only. Moreover, based on requests received from friendly foreign countries/institutions, Ministry of Education disseminates information on scholarships

offered by such donor countries for Indian students of all the States and Union Territories to study abroad. The students are required to apply online <http://proposal.sakshat.ac.in/scholarship>. The details of the schemes and programmes being implemented by different Ministries under which financial assistance and interest subsidy are provided to meritorious students for pursuing higher education abroad are available in following websites:
