DEVELOPMENT OF PANCHAYATS IN TAMIL NADU

Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds allocated by Government for the development of Gram Panchayats in the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise and year-wise details for last five years;
- (b) the details of the Panchayats in the State of Tamil Nadu which have been computerized; district-wise details thereof; and
- (c) the total number of Panchayats, which have been computerized in the said State?

(a) The year-wise funds allocated/released to Panchayats in the State of Tamil Nadu under the (i) Fourteenth and Fifteenth Finance Commissions and under (ii) the scheme Incentivization of Panchayats (IoP) under which awards including financial incentives are given to the best performing Panchayats in recognition of their good work for improving delivery of services and public goods during the last five years and (iii) to the States under the Scheme of Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) and for capacity building of the elected representatives and their functionaries of the Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) are as under:
