CORPORATISATION OF ORDNANCE FACTORIES

841. DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

(a) the number of ordnance factories in the country, including Rajasthan and the Statewisedetails thereof;

(b) whether Government has decided to corporatise the ordnance factories;

(c) whether these 41 ordnance factories are proposed to be converted into sevencorporations;

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(e) the reaction of employees/unions/federations/organisations in this regard;

(f) whether Government has conducted any study of the nation's security and defencepreparations and the interests of the employees working in the said factories; and

(g) if so, the details of the likely impact thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE

(SHRI AJAY BHATT)

(a): There are 41 Ordnance Factories in the country. However, there is no Ordnance Factory in the state of Rajasthan. The state-wise list is attached as Annexure-A.

(b) to (d):In pursuance of the decision of the Union Cabinet on 16th June, 2021 to enhance functional autonomy, efficiency and unleash new growth potential and innovation in Ordnance Factories, the production units of Ordnance Factory Boardhave been converted into 7 Defence Public Sector Undertakings(wholly owned by the Government of India)namely (i) Munitions India Limited, (ii) Armoured Vehicles Nigam Limited, (iii) Advanced Weapons and Equipment India Limited, (iv) Troop Comforts Limited, (v) Yantra India Limited, (vi) India Optel Limited, and (vii) Gliders India Limitedwith 41 units, with effect from 1stOctober 2021 ("The Appointed Date"). The details are attached as Annexure-B.

(e): Many Federations, Associations and unions of employees of erstwhile Ordnance Factory Board have represented against the decision of Government to corporatize Ordnance Factory Board. (f) & (g): The Department had selected M/s KPMG Advisory Services Pvt. Ltd (Lead Consortium Member) along with M/s Khaitan& Co. Ltd as other Consortium Member, as the Consultancy Agency for providing strategic and implementation management consulting services to assist the Department in the process of corporatization of the Ordnance Factory Board, including on Human Resource related matters. The Government has taken the following steps to protect the interests of employees and workers of Ordnance Factory Board (OFB):-

(i) All the employees of OFB (Group A, B & C) belonging to the production units and also the identified non-production units have been transferred enmasse to the New DPSUs on terms of foreign service, without any deputation allowance (deemed deputation) initially for a period of two years from the Appointed Date.

(ii) Till such time, the employees remain on deemed deputation to the new DPSUs, they shall continue to be subject to all the extant rules, regulations and orders as are applicable to the Central Government servants, includingrelated to their pay scales, allowances, leave, medical facilities, career progression and other service conditions.

(iii) All the employees of OFB (Group A, B & C) belonging to OFB Headquarters (at Kolkata), OFB New Delhi Office, OF Schools and OF Hospitals have been transferred enmasse to the Directorate of Ordnance (Coordination & Services) under the Department of Defence Production, initially for a period of two years from the Appointed Date.

(iv) The pension liabilities of the retirees and existing employees will continue to be borne by the Government. For the employees recruited after 01.01.2004, National Pension Scheme applicable to the Central Government employees is in vogue and the same has been adopted by the New DPSUs, including continuation of all special provisions applicable to Central Government employees under the National Pension System.
