**COMPLETION OF PROJECTS UNDER CSR
QUESTION**

990 SHRI HARBHAJAN SINGH:

Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the projects which have not been completed under the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), along with the reasons therefor;
- (b) the details of the works completed under the said projects, sector-wise;
- (c) the nodal agencies of the projects which have not completed the projects;
- (d) whether any action has been taken against the nodal agencies for not completing the projects on time; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e): Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor the CSR activities based on the recommendations of its CSR Committee. Section 135 of the Act read with Rule 4 of the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014 prescribes that the Board of the company is empowered to undertake its CSR activities either by itself or through Implementing Agencies as mentioned in the said rule. The Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014 was amended on 22nd January, 2021 and registration of Implementing Agencies with the Central Government is mandatory with effect from 1st April, 2021. The CSR framework is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. On the basis of annual filings made by the Companies in the MCA 21 registry, the Development Sector-wise details of CSR spent by Companies during financial years 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 is at Annexure and can also be accessed at www.csr.gov.in. However, completion status of CSR projects is not maintained by the Government. Whenever any violation of CSR provisions is reported, action against such non-compliant Companies are initiated as per provisions of Companies Act, 2013 after due examination of records and following due process of law.
