Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of Skill Development Centres in various States, including Uttar Pradesh under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana(PMKVY), district-wise; and
- (b) whether Government has formulated any scheme to provide employment to the youth getting training from the said Training Centres and if so, the details thereof?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) AND (B) IN RESPECT OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 157 FOR REPLY ON 21.12.2022 REGARDING SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRES BY SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR.**

(a): Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is delivering skills to the youth of the country including State of Uttar Pradesh through a network of skill development centres. Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), short term training is being imparted in empanelled training centres (TCs) including model and aspirational training centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK).

The training centres (TCs) including PMKKs which have imparted skill training under PMKVY 1.0, 2.0 and 3.0 are 12,218; 15,151 and 4,459; respectively. The State/UT-wise number of PMKVY training centres (TCs) including PMKKs which imparted training under PMKVY, since 2015, as on 30.09.2022, is given at *Annexure I*.

The district-wise details of TCs including PMKKs which imparted skill training under PMKVY are given at *Annexure II*. Since the details in aforesaid *Annexure II* are too lengthy, it is uploaded on Ministry's website at <https://msde.gov.in/en/useful-links/parl-ques/rajya-sabha>.

(b): Ministry has not formulated any exclusive scheme to provide employment to the youth getting training in Training Centres under PMKVY; however, under PMKVY, Ministry has facilitated the placement of the trained candidates through various initiatives such as organization of Rozgar Melas, incentivization of placement, etc.

PMKVY has two training components namely; Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Under PMKVY, placement opportunities are provided to STT certified candidates, while RPL involves the process of certification of already existing skills in workers and it is not linked with placements. Under PMKVY-STT, since inception i.e. 2015 upto 30.09.2022, 24.30 lakh candidates have been reported placed in various sectors across the country.
