FOUR LANE STATUS OF ULUNDURPET - SALEM NH 68 IN TAMIL NADU

*5. SHRI K.R.N. RAJESHKUMAR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that, number of accidents are happening in Ulundurpet Salem NH 68 in Tamil Nadu due to non completion of NH into four lanes;
- (b) if so, what is the current status of Ulundurpet Salem NH 68 in Tamil Nadu; and
- (c) by when the above said NH will be converted into full stretch four lane National Highway?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 5 ANSWERED ON 7TH DECEMBER, 2022 ASKED BY SHRI K.R.N. RAJESHKUMAR REGARDING 'FOUR LANE STATUS OF ULUNDURPET – SALEM NH 68 IN TAMIL NADU'.

(a) to (c) Yes Sir. Accidents have been reported. The work of four laning of Salem – Ulundurpet section of NH-79 (Old NH-68) was commenced on 15.01.2008 with a concession period of 25 years. As per provisions of the Concession Agreement (CA), out of 136.36 Km, 97.97 km was to be constructed as four-lane and 38.39 km comprising 8 bypasses was to be constructed as two-lane with paved shoulders. The four-laning work on the stretch from km 0.313 to km 45.765 (excluding 2 bypasses) was completed on 01.09.2013 and four-laning work on the balance stretch from km 45.765 to km 136.670 (excluding 6 bypasses) was completed on 28.07.2012. As per the provisions of Concession Agreement, the four-laning work of 6 bypasses is scheduled to complete by July'2023 and four-laning work of balance 2 bypasses is scheduled to complete by August'2024.
