# STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 67\* FOR 13<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2022

As per the Global TB Report 2022 released by World Health Organisation (WHO), India accounts for 27.83% of the estimated Global TB cases in 2021. The estimated TB cases for the year 2021 Globally and in India is 106 lakhs and 29.5 lakhs respectively.

The total number of TB cases notified under National TB Elimination Programme is 21.46 lakhs in 2021. The state-wise details of TB cases notified in 2021 (January – December) and 2022 (January to 1<sup>st</sup> December), is annexed.
