PROMOTION OF DAIRY INDUSTRY IN TELANGANA

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the schemes being run by Government to promote dairy industry in the State of Telangana;
- (b) the details of places where the largest number of dairies are functional in the State of Telangana; and
- (c) the details of grants being provided to States related to dairy industries?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

- (a) In order to supplement the efforts of the States, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India is implementing following dairy development schemes, wherein provisions have been made to provide financial assistance to dairy cooperatives and milk producer companies, primarily for strengthening/creation of dairy infrastructure for quality milk procurement, processing, marketing of milk and milk products and to meet working capital requirement: -
 - i. National Programme for Dairy Development
 - ii. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund
 - iii. Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organisations engaged in dairy activities

In addition to above, efforts made by Government of Telangana to promote dairy industry in Telangana are as under;

- (i) Providing Rs 4/- per litre cash incentive to milk producers who supply milk to Telangana State Dairy Development Cooperative Federation (TSDDCF).
- (ii) Launched Milch Animals Distribution Scheme by providing one milch animal to the members of Cooperative Societies with 75% subsidy to SC & ST beneficiaries and 50% subsidy to others.

(b) The Telangana State Dairy Development Cooperative Federation (TSDDCF) is operating in 31 districts with 16 milk sheds. They procured about 2.3 Lakh Kilogram per day (average) and sold about 3.41 Lakh Liters per day (average) during 2021-22. Among dairy cooperatives in Telangana, TSDDCF has the largest milk processing plant of 475 thousand litres per day capacity, located at Hyderabad.

(c) The details of funds released to the States across the country and funds allocated under dairy development schemes of the Department during last three years and the current financial year are as under: -
