(a) & (b): Baddi-Chandigarh (33 Km) New Rail Line Project is a cost sharing project wherein Government of Himachal Pradesh is sharing 50% of cost.

Land acquisition between Baddi to Chandigarh has been taken up as detailed below:

- Himachal Pradesh (34.66 Ha involved in 9 villages): 30.32 Land (Private- 28.72 Ha, Govt.- 1.6 Ha) already acquired and balance 4.346 Ha (Private- 4.096 Ha and Govt.- 0.25 Ha) in progress.
- Haryana (60.21 Ha involved in 21 villages): Complete 60.21 Ha (Private- 44.33 Ha, Govt.- 15.66 Ha and forest- 0.22 Ha) has been acquired.
