STOPPAGE OF SAMPOORNA KRANTI EXPRESS AT BUXAR

1266. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Railways would allow stoppage of 12393/12394 Rajendra Nagar-New Delhi Sampoorna Kranti Express at Buxar station in view of huge demand from public of the adjoining districts of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) whether Railways would consider introduction of a new Super Fast/Tejas or new Rajdhani Express on this route with stoppage at Buxar in view of number of passengers therein;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (f) Buxar station is presently being served by 52 pairs of Mail/Express train services including 17 pairs of Mail/Express train services which are providing direct connectivity between Buxar and Delhi. Presently, there is no proposal for stoppage of 12393/12394 Rajendra Nagar-New Delhi Sampoorna Kranti Express at Buxar station owing to operational constraints. However, introduction of new train services/stoppage of trains is an ongoing process over Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic demand, availability of alternate services, resource availability etc.
