**EXPENDITURE INCURRED ON CLEANING THE RIVERS YAMUNA AND GANGA**

Namami Gange Programme was launched in June 2014 for a period up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2021 to rejuvenate River Ganga and its tributaries including Yamuna. The programme was subsequently extended up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2026.

The details of release of funds by Government of India to National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) from Financial Year 2017-18 and in the current year (till 31 October 2022) and funds released/expended under the Programme during the said period are as under:-

Being a tributary to River Ganga, rejuvenation of River Yamuna is also part of the Namami Gange Programme. NMCG has released funds for implementation of projects in Haryana, Delhi, Himachal Pradesh & Uttar Pradesh with the objective to reduce pollution in River Yamuna. The funds released by NMCG to various agencies for the said projects, compiled State-wise, from 2017-18 up to 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2022, are as under:
