Namami Gange Programme was launched in June 2014 for a period up to 31st March, 2021 to rejuvenate River Ganga and its tributaries including Yamuna. The programme was subsequently extended up to 31stMarch, 2026.

The details of release of funds by Government of India to National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) from Financial Year 2017-18 and in the current year (till 31 October 2022) and funds released/expended under the Programme during the said period are as under:-
