STATUS OF JJM IN ANDHRA PRADESH

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) the percentage of households in the rural areas in the State of Andhra Pradesh that have been provided potable tap water supply;
- (b) whether Government will be able to achieve 100 per cent target under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in the State of Andhra Pradesh; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) Since August, 2019, Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), is being implemented in partnership with States, to make provision of potable tap water connection to every rural household of the country including those in Andhra Pradesh.

As reported by State, as on 13.12.2022, out of total 95.69 Lakh rural households in Andhra Pradesh, 64.07 Lakh (66.96%) households have been provided a tap water connection. As per the plan prepared by the State Government, the remaining 31.62 Lakh tap connections are planned to be covered by March, 2024.
