**INFRASTRUCTURE FOR LPG PIPELINES**

1407. SHRI NARESH BANSAL:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government proposes to establish infrastructure for LPG pipelines across the country to cater to effective distribution of LPG especially in Uttarakhand;
- (b) if so, the details of the LPG pipeline projects under construction, sanctioned and to be considered for sanction in near future; and
- (c) if so, by when towns of Uttarakhand will get gas pipelines and the progress of the LPG gas pipe line in Uttarakhand and the details thereof?

(a) to (c) For effective distribution of LPG throughout the country, 4013 Km of LPG pipeline is already laid and functional. In addition, following pipeline expansion projects are underway in various States:

At present, there is no authorized LPG pipeline/LPG pipeline expansion project covering the State of Uttarakhand. However, authorization by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) has been issued for the development of Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) and Piped Natural Gas (PNG) network for the entire State of Uttarakhand.

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
