Loans granted under PMMY in different States

1482. DR. C.M. RAMESH :

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of total loans granted under Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) to different States of the country during the last three years, State-wise; and
- (b) whether any survey has been undertaken by Government regarding the number of beneficiaries across manufacturing and trading sectors under PMMY during the last three years, if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The State/UT-wise details of loans extended under PMMY during the last three financial years are annexed.
- (b) Ministry of Labour and Employment (MoLE) in its report dated October 2019 has informed that a large sample survey at the national level was conducted to assess employment generation under PMMY. As per the survey results, PMMY helped in generating 1.12 crore net additional employment during a period of approximately 3 years (i.e. from 2015 to 2018). At an overall level, Shishu category of loan constitutes about 66% of share among additional employment generated by establishments owned by MUDRA beneficiaries followed by Kishore (19%) and Tarun (15%) categories respectively.
