(a) to (d): As per information provided by the Executing Agency approximately 75% of civil work of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Guwahati has been completed. MBBS classes for 50 students have started from the academic session 2020-21. The Ministry closely monitors the progress of new AIIMS projects. A Project Review Committee has also been constituted. Approved cost of the project is Rs.1123 crore, out of which, till date Rs.717.38 cr has been released by this Ministry.
