SCHEMES FOR WELFARE OF WOMEN AND CHILDREN

159. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of schemes being run by Government for welfare of women and children in the country during current financial year; and
- (b) the details of fund allocated, released and utilized during 2022-23 till date under above schemes, State-wise and scheme-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) To ensure better monitoring and efficient implementation, all the schemes being implemented by the Ministry for welfare of women and children in the country have been clubbed together into three verticals, viz. (1) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 (2) Mission Shakti (3) Mission Vatsalya. The details of these schemes are as under:
- (i) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0:This programme has been reorganized into 3 primary verticals: (i) Nutrition Support for Children, Adolescent Girls and Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers (ii) Early Childhood Care and Education [3-6 years] and (iii) Anganwadi Infrastructure including modern, upgraded Saksham Anganwadis.
- (ii) Mission Shakti: Mission Shakti comprises of two sub-schemes 'Sambal' and 'Samarthya' for safety and security of women and empowerment of women respectively. The existing schemes of One Stop Centres (OSC), Women Helplines (181-WHL) and Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) together with a new component of Nari Adalat have been made part of Sambal sub- scheme; while the schemes of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), Shakti Sadan (Ujjwala & Swadhar Greh), Working Women Hostel (Sakhi Niwas) and National Creche Scheme (Palna) have been subsumed in 'Samarthya'.
- (iii) Mission Vatsalya: Under the scheme, support is provided for delivering services for children in need and in difficult circumstances universally across the country; develop context-based solutions for holistic development of children from varied backgrounds. The

Child Care Institutions (CCIs) established under the scheme support inter-alia ageappropriate education, access to vocational training, recreation, health care, counselling etc. and covers both rural and urban children.
