**FUNDS PROVIDED FOR CLASSICAL LANGUAGES**

Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Indian languages which have been conferred, the status of classical language till now;
- (b) whether Government has implemented any scheme to provide financial assistance to various projects pertaining to classical languages in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the language-wise details of funds provided for each classical language during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (e) whether Government has any proposal regarding classical language projects during the last two years; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and Government's reaction thereto?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d): Six Indian languages namely Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam and Odia have been accorded the status of Classical Language. The policy of the Government is to promote all Indian languages including classical languages. Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL) works for the promotion of all Indian languages including four classical languages viz. Kannada, Telugu, Malayalam and Odia. Development and promotion of Classical Tamil is done by Central Institute of Classical Tamil (CICT). The Government of India is promoting Sanskrit Language through three Central Universities. Funds are provided to these universities for teaching and research in Sanskrit Language leading to award of degree, diploma, certificate to students and no separate funds are provided for undertaking any work related to classical aspect of Sanskrit.

The detail of funds allocated for various classical languages is given below:-
