(a) & (b) Six new Central Universities have been established under the administrative control of the Ministry of Education during last five years. This includes three deemed to be Universities converted into Central University through Central Sanskrit University Act, 2020. The details are as under:

1.	Central University of Andhra Pradesh	Ananthpur, Andhra Pradesh
2.	Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh	Vijaynagaram, Andhra Pradesh
3.	Sindhu Central University	Khaltsi, Ladakh
4.	Central Sanskrit University (CSU)	Janakpuri Institutional Area, Delhi
5.	Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit Universities (SLBSNSU)	Katwaria Sarai, New Delhi
6.	National Sanskrit University (NSU)	Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh
