Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Rajasthan are the best performing States in school education in the country as per 2020-21 Performance Grade Index of the Ministry;
- (b) the details of indicators taken into account in arriving at the above level; and
- (c) how Ministry help financially and otherwise above States to reach level-I, with a particular reference to Andhra Pradesh?

(a) and (b): The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education has designed a 70 indicator based Performance Grading Index (PGI) to grade the States and Union Territories in the field of school education. The scores obtained by the States/UTs in PGI during 2017-18 to 2020-21 is at Annexure-I. The list of indicators used for arriving the score of PGI are available at Annexure III of the PGI report 2020-21 and the same can be accessed at <https://pgi.udiseplus.gov.in/PGI-State-2020-21-Brochure.pdf>.

(c): The Performance Grading Index (PGI) of all States and UTs including Andhra Pradesh has been discussed during the Project Approval Board (PAB) meetings. Based on the performance of the state, the activities suggested to the States/UTs in such PAB meetings, includes teacher training in assessment as learning, State text book analysis, use of early language kit and early mathematics kit developed by NCERT, training in child friendly assessment practices for teachers, documentation of best practices in Pre-NAS and Post-NAS in the States/UTs for improvement in learning levels, Use of NAS data to prepare their AWPB. Further, the Department of School Education and Literacy through Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Samagra Shiksha also provides financial assistance to the States and UTs including Andhra Pradesh for various activities to improve enrolment in Govt. schools, opening/strengthening of new schools up to senior secondary level, strengthening school infrastructure, setting up, up gradation and running of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBV) upto clas 12, setting up of residential schools/hostel named Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas, aids and appliances for children with special needs, provision of vocational education and ICT facilities in schools, etc,. Further, education being a concurrent subject, States and Union Territories are also expected to undertake this activity.
