ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT IN ASSAM

1673. SHRI PABITRA MARGHERITA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the amount allocated for National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) projects in Assam;
- (b) the actual utilization of funds from the allocated amount for the State of Assam; and
- (c) the total length of National Highways developed in Assam as compared from 2013 to 2022?

(a) Sir, there is no such state-specific allocation made to the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) for the National Highway (NH) Projects. The budget is allocated projects-wise, as per project requirements, within the sanctioned projects costs.

(b) The fund allocation and utilization of fund in the State of Assam is as under:
