PERFORMANCE OF PMAY-G

1691 DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) details of the performance of the Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) in the country over the last five years;
- (b) details of the performance of the States under PMAY-G over the past five years;
- (c) whether State of Odisha has been awarded at any time for their performance under PMAY-G; and
- (d) total expenditure incurred by Government of India for this PMAY-G programme and total houses constructed in the past five years in a State-wise and year-wise format?

(a) & (b) In order to achieve the target of “Housing for All” in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1st April, 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households with an overall target to construct 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by March, 2024. Over the last five years i.e. from financial year 2017-18 to 2021-22, the States/UTs have sanctioned houses to 2,08,10,125 beneficiaries and construction of 1,80,56,170 houses have been completed under PMAY-G.

(c) The State of Odisha has not been awarded for their performance under PMAY-G by the Ministry of Rural Development in the years 2018 and 2019.

(d) The total Central Share released by the Government of India under PMAY-G to the various States/UTs since inception i.e. 01.04.2016 till 15.12.2022 is Rs.1,83,845.30 crore. The Year-wise and State-wise number of houses constructed during the above period is given in **Annexure**.
