PMAY-G IN GUJARAT

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of houses that have been constructed so far under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G);
- (b) the total number of houses constructed in Gujarat under this scheme;
- (c) whether the Government has set any target to construct more houses under PMAY-G; and
- (d) if so, the total number of houses that have been targeted to be constructed by the year 2024, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) The total number of houses that have been constructed so far since inception i.e. 01.04.2016 till 15.12.2022 under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) are 2,11,17,169. The total number of houses constructed in Gujarat under PMAY-G are 3,99,721.

(c) & (d) In order to achieve the target of “Housing for All” in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1st April, 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households with overall target to construct 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by March, 2024. Out of this, a total of 2,49,98,226 houses have been sanctioned to beneficiaries and 2,11,17,169 houses have already been completed as on 15.12.2022. Remaining 83,82,831 houses are to be constructed by 2024 under the scheme.
