PERFORMANCE OF TRAINING PROGRAMMES UNDER DDU-GKY

1704 SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has achieved the objective for which Deen Dayal Upadhyaya-Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) was launched and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the number of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Kendras (DDU-GKK) operating in various parts of the country alongwith the number of training programmes being run in these Kendras;
- (c) whether Government has utilized the funds allocated for DDU-GKK during each of the last five years; and
- (d) the minimum placement rate given in the DDU-GKY along with the actual placement rate State/UT- wise and year-wise for last five years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a) Sir, Deen Dayal Upadhyay-Grameen Kaushal Yojana (DDU-GKY) is an ongoing scheme and achieving its objective of making rural poor youth employable by imparting skill training and a good number of the youth skilled under this program are getting employed in jobs having regular monthly wages equal to or above the minimum wages notified by the State. The Statewise details of the achievement during each of the last five years and current year are given at **Anenxure-I**
- (b) DDU-GKY follows a 3-tier implementation architecture for implementation. National level is responsible for policy making, funding of central share and technical support, while State Rural Livelihood Missions (SRLMs) or State Skill Development Missions are responsible for funding of State share, implementation and monitoring. Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs), which are mostly private training partners, are responsible for mobilization, training and placement of candidates. PIAs establish and run training centres as per requirement of the projects, under the DDU-GKY norms. State-wise number of training centres being operated by PIAs in the country are given at **Anexure-II**. Data of the number of training programs being run in these training centres is not maintained by the Ministry.
- (c) DDU-GKY is a placement linked demand driven scheme. Under this scheme, funds are released to the States on the basis of their approved targets. The details of total funds allocated for DDU-GKY scheme and the total funds released to all the States/UTs under the scheme during each of the last five years and current year are given below:
