MONUMENTS OF NATIONAL IMPORTANCE IN KERALA

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:-

- (a) details of monuments and sites that are declared as monuments of national importance in the State of Kerala by the Archaeological Survey of India;
- (b) the total funds allotted for the preservation of these monuments and sites during the last three years;
- (c) the revenue earned from these monuments during the last three years; and
- (d) whether Government propose to declare any other monument or sites as monument of national importance in Kerala, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) A total number of 29 monuments/sites have been declared as of national importance under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1958 in Kerala. Details are given in the list at Annexure.
- (b) The fund allotted for preservation, conservation and maintenance of these monuments/sites during the last three years is as under:

- (c) The revenue earned from the monuments/sites of national importance in Kerala during the last three years is as under:
