CRITERIA FOR IDENTIFYING THE BENEFICIARIES UNDER PMMVY

1745. SHRI TIRUCHI SIVA:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the criteria for identifying the beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY);
- (b) the details of the number of beneficiaries who have been identified by Government;
- (c) the details of funds spent under the scheme, State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu;
- (d) the details of provisions made to monitor the implementation of the said scheme at the district level; and
- (e) whether Government has set a timeline to ensure the benefits of the scheme reach the targeted beneficiaries and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT
(SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) The Mission Shakti Scheme Guidelines of which Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) is a component, provides that maternity benefits to be provided to beneficiaries belonging to socially and economically disadvantaged section of the society. The Mission Shakti Scheme Guidelines are applicable from 01.04.2022.

(b) & (c) Till 21.11.2022, more than 3.11 crore beneficiaries have been enrolled and more than 2.77 crore beneficiaries have been paid more than Rs. 12,150 crores as maternity benefit under PMMVY. During the current financial year, more than 38.29 lakh beneficiaries have been enrolled under PMMVY from 01.04.2022 till 21.11.2022. The State/UT-wise details of funds, including the State of Tamil Nadu, are annexed.

(d) The Mission Shakti Scheme Guidelines provides for establishment of District level Monitoring Committee under the Chairpersonship of District Magistrate (DM)/District Collector (DC) for monitoring the implementation of the scheme at district level. These guidelines also envisage web-based reporting system for real time monitoring of implementation of the scheme.

(e) The Mission Shakti Guidelines provide payment of maternity benefits in the account of eligible beneficiaries preferably within 30 days of registration and submission of claim along with complete details of fulfillment of conditionalities under the scheme.
