# RAJYA SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1755 TO BE ANSWERED ON 21.12.2022

#### STATUS OF VARIOUS SCHEMES RELATED TO WOMEN SAFETY

#### 1755. SHRI SANJAY SINGH:

Will the Minister of Women and Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the rate of crime against women has increased by 15.8 percent during the last three years;
- (b) the year-wise details of the amount allocated and released to the Ministry of Home Affairs and other concerned Ministries from Nirbhaya Fund till the year 2021-22;
- (c) Ministry-wise details of the percentage of funds utilized by the Ministries so far; and
- (d) increase in cyber crime against women in the last five years and the details of amount from the Nirbhaya Fund used for its prevention and schemes related thereto?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) : National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) compiles and publishes data on crimes, including rate of crime against women, in its publication 'Crime in India', which is available in public domain at their website i.e. https://ncrb.gov.in/en/crime-india.
- (b) & (c): The projects/ schemes under Nirbhaya Fund are demand driven. Under Nirbhaya Framework, an Empowered Committee (EC) of Officers have been constituted that appraises and recommends the project proposals of Ministries/ Departments and State Governments for funding under Nirbhaya Fund. After the projects are appraised and recommended by the EC, the responsibility of its execution lies on the concerned Ministries / State Governments to utilise funds from their respective budget after obtaining approval of their respective financial authorities. As per information received from the concerned Ministries / Departments, the details of the projects appraised by EC for funding under Nirbhaya Fund along with amount released and utilized under the project are given in Annexure.
- (d): As per data published by NCRB, the number of cyber crimes against women in the year 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 were 4,242, 6,030, 8,379, 10,405, and 10,730, respectively.

The Government has been implementing a scheme, namely Cyber Crime Prevention against Women and Children (CCPWC), under Nirbhaya Fund under which various activities related to prevention of cyber crimes against women and children are undertaken. An amount of Rs. 152.22 crore has been reported as utilised under the said scheme.
