- (a): The Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) has received proposal from the State Government of Punjab to set up ESI hospitals at the following 6 locations:
 - i. Sector-66, Sahibzada Ajit Singh (SAS) Nagar, District SAS Nagar
 - ii. Lalru, District SAS Nagar
 - iii. Rajpura, District Patiala
 - iv. Malerkotla, District Malerkotla
 - v. Doraha, District Ludhiana.
 - vi. Bathinda, District Bathinda

Setting up of ESI hospital is an ongoing process and is based on the number of Insured Persons (IPs) in an area in accordance with the norms of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation
