- (a) the total number of posts of IAS/IPS sanctioned and currently vacant in the country, State-wise:
- (b) the number of posts of IAS/IPS to which promotion will be done through direct recruitment and State service in the State of Rajasthan and which are currently vacant, the steps being taken by the Central Government to fill these posts at the earliest; and
- (c) whether the State Government has made any demand to the Central Government to fill these posts, if so, the details thereof?

(a): The details of sanctioned strength and vacancies of IAS and IPS officers as on 01.01.2022 are as under:

State-wise details are placed at Annexure A.

(b) & (c): The direct recruitment to IAS and IPS is made on the basis of the Civil Services Examination (CSE) conducted annually by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC). Requisitions are sought by the Central Government from the State Cadres/Joint-Cadres for filling up these vacancies on the basis of a particular CSE. For CSE-2021, the State Government of Rajasthan had made a requisition of 9(Nine) IAS Officers and 6(Six) IPS officers. The requisition made for IAS has been fulfilled by allocating 9(Nine) Officers to the Rajasthan cadre.

Further, induction of Officers in IAS/IPS from State Services is done by the Central Government in consultation with the State Governments concerned and on the recommendations of UPSC. During the year 2022, all the 5 vacancies that occurred in the promotion quota of the Rajasthan Cadre of IAS have been filled up. As regards IPS, out of 07 vacancies determined under the promotion quota, 06 have been filled up.
