## ENHANCING THE CAPACITY OF TOURIST GUIDES

#### 1900. SHRI DHANANJAY BHIMRAO MAHADIK:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has failed to enhance the capacity of tourist guides in the country and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether there is a severe shortage of approved tourist guides in the country and if so, the steps taken to remove the shortage;
- (c) whether Government propose to introduce special course in colleges/institutes specializing in hospitality and tourism for enhanced capacity building of these tourist guides and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of institutes that carry out human resource development in the country, State-wise and specialization-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (c): With the objective of creating a pool of well trained and professional Tourist Facilitators/Guides across the country, the Ministry of Tourism has launched Pan-India Incredible India Tourist Facilitator (IITF) Certification Program w.e.f. 01.01.2020. It is a digital initiative that has created an Online learning platform, wherein, candidates can pursue these online courses from anywhere and at any time and at their own pace. The system provides basic, advanced IITG (heritage and adventure), spoken language and refresher courses for candidates. So far, Incredible India Tourist Facilitator Basic Course online exam has been conducted for three times, wherein, a total 3795 candidates have completed the IITF Basic exam. IITG (Heritage) course has been launched by IITTM on 03.08.2022 on IITF portal and is open for registration.

The existing Regional Level Guides (RLGs) have been renamed as Incredible India Tourist Guide (IITG) and they have been integrated with this new system of IITF/IITG. The nomenclature of existing Regional Level Guide (RLG) will be changed to Incredible India Tourist Guide (IITG) on completion of the Refresher Course being conducted by the Indian Institute of Tourism & Travel Management (IITTM), and their area of operation has been widened from a specified region to Pan India.

The Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management (IITTM), which is an autonomous institute of the Ministry of Tourism, is the implementing agency for the IITFC and IITG programme.

(d): Ministry of Tourism through various institutes including institutes of States/UTs, run courses for human resource development in the country. State-wise and specialization-wise list of such institutes is annexed at Annexure.
