Will the Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM);
- (b) the funds allocated and expenditure incurred under the said mission in Uttar Pradesh, including Firozabad, Agra and Mainpuri districts, during the last three years, including the current financial year, the details thereof; and
- (c) the norms stipulated for all States in the country, including Uttar Pradesh for monitoring the progress of RGM and the current status of implementation of said Mission, including the number of beneficiaries thereof, the State-wise details thereof?

ANSWER

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM) for development and conservation of indigenous bovine breeds since December 2014. The scheme is important for enhancing milk production and productivity of bovines to meet the growing demand of milk and making dairying more remunerative for the rural farmers of the country. The scheme is continued under revised and realigned scheme of the Department from 2021-22 to 2025-26 with an allocation of Rs.2400 crore.

(b) The funds released and expenditure incurred under Rashtriya Gokul Mission in Uttar Pradesh including Firozabad, Agra and Mainpuri districts during the last 3 years, including the current financial year is as under
