VETERINARIANS IN THE COUNTRY

2016 DR. K. KESHAVA RAO:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Ministry compile the data related to the number of veterinarians practicing in the country;
- b) if so, the State-wise details thereof, if not, the reasons therefore; and
- c) the steps taken to follow the recommendations of the Veterinary Council of India (VCI) to increase the health ecosystem of animal husbandry in the country?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & DAIRYING

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

a) Yes Sir, the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying compiles the data related to number of veterinarians practicing in the country. This is done through the Veterinary Council of India (VCI) as per the provisions of section 23 of the IVC Act, 1984. The VCI is mandated to maintain an Indian Veterinary Practitioners Register (IVPR). This register is updated with the data received from States/UTs by 31st March of every year. Only the registered veterinary practitioners are allowed to practice as per section 30 of IVC Act, 1984.

b) The State-wise details are enclosed at Annexure-1.

c) The Central Government is implementing the recommendations made by VCI with respect to monitoring of veterinary colleges, standards of veterinary education, course curriculum, and also recognition of veterinary colleges. The educational standards are revised from time to time to update to the level of global norms. The recommendations w.r.t setting up of Veterinary colleges in Government and Private sector and inclusion of Veterinary colleges in 1st schedule and 2nd schedule are considered by the Central Government.

The Central Government through the VCI and State Veterinary Councils, are empowered to mandate the registration of practitioners, ethics in veterinary practice and also ensure proper service delivery as well as take action against unscrupulous practitioners as per the provisions of the IVC Act.
