(a) total amount of credit linked subsidy provided under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro food processing Enterprises (PMFME) scheme;

(b) the State-wise data of number of micro food processing units who availed this subsidy;

(c) the average time it takes to process the application and disbursal of subsidy;

(d) whether the profitability of these micro enterprises has increased after receiving capacity building support; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a). The total amount of Center Share of credit linked subsidy provided under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme is Rs. 110.86 crore.

(b). The State-wise data of number of micro food processing units who availed this subsidy is at **Annexure**.

(c). The average time taken to process the application by the States and the Banks is 81 days and for disbursal of subsidy, it is 30 days.

(d) & (e). Capacity building and training is a critical component in technical upgradation and formalization of micro food processing enterprises which helps them in understanding the requirements for setting up / upgradation related to technology, quality and safety standards prescribed by Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI), Udyam Registration, Goods & Services Tax (GST) Registration, good hygiene practices, packaging, storage, procurement, new products development etc. including profitability of the micro enterprises.
