**TELANGANA NATIVES WORKING OVERSEAS**

230. SHRI B. PARTHASARADHI REDDY:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has the official data on natives from the State of Telangana working in different part of the world;
- (b) if so, the details of natives of Telangana working in respective countries thereof, district-wise;
- (c) whether any Monitoring mechanisms are working to safeguard the welfare of natives from Telangana working overseas; and
- (d) if so, the details of such mechanisms, along with country-wise contact details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) Official data on natives from the state of Telangana working in different part of the world as available in eMigrate portal for ECR countries is attached as Annexure I.

(c) & (d) The Government has established a robust institutional framework to ensure the welfare, safety and well-being of Indian migrants living overseas. The e-Migrate system, MADAD portal, Indian Community Welfare Fund, Pravasi Bhartiya Beema Yojana, Pravasi Bhartiya Sahayata Kendras, Pravasi Bhartiya Sahayata Kendras Helplines at Indian Missions and Posts, open house programs organized by the Missions and Posts, Shelter Homes etc. are some of the important mechanisms to expeditiously assist Indian migrants abroad. In addition, the Government has signed Labour, Employment and Cooperation agreements with major destination countries including the Gulf countries and holds Joint Working Groups meetings to ensure redressal of grievances and protection of rights of Indian workers.

Indian migrant workers in distress or facing harassment, breach of employment contract etc can register their complaints directly with respective Indian Mission/Post (through 24x7 contact numbers available at websites of all Indian Missions/Posts abroad) or through any of Protector of Emigrants office, MADAD portal, CPGRAM portal and eMigrate portal.

In addition to the above, for creating awareness about safe and legal migration, the Ministry of External Affairs has launched the '*Surakshit Jaaye Prasikshit Jaaye – Go Safe Go Trained*' campaign.
