Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of beneficiaries having been registered on the labour portal in Rajasthan, the details of the funds spent for the welfare of said beneficiaries in Jodhpur district;
- (b)whether Government proposes to extend/provide the benefits of Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY) to other beneficiaries in the country, including the State of Rajasthan, if so, the details thereof and by when it would be extended; and
- (c)if not, the reasons therefor and whether Government is considering to give the benefit of PM Arogya Yojana to these beneficiaries in Rajasthan, in future?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

- (a): As on 01.12.2022, the number of workers registered on e-SHRAM portal was 1,27,12,612 in the State of Rajasthan. Government of Rajasthan has informed that no fund has been spent for the welfare of these registered workers in Jodhpur district.
- (b) & (c): Certain categories of unorganized workers who are eligible as per the set criteria (occupation criteria in urban areas and deprivation criteria in rural areas) and identified from the Socio Economic Caste Census, 2011 are covered under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojna (PM-JAY).
