- (a) 'Sports' being a State subject, the responsibility to promote sports rests primarily with the respective State/Union Territory Governments. The Union Government supplements their efforts. 2841 & 8968 sportspersons have been supported under Khelo India Scheme and Sports Promotional Schemes respectively.
- (b) The number of sportspersons who have been provided financial support/scholarships under the Khelo India Scheme during the last five years is given below:-
