Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has any plan to sufficiently supplement the efforts of the State Governments with regard to promotion of sports; and

(b) if so, the status of assistance, financial or otherwise, extended to States during the last three years, State and UT-wise with a particular reference to Haryana and Delhi?

(a) to (b) 'Sports' being a State subject, the responsibility of promotion of sports rests primarily with the respective State/Union Territory Governments. The Union Government supplements their efforts by bridging critical gaps. The details of financial assistance provided to States/UTs, including Haryana and Delhi, under various schemes/programmes of the Department of Sports during the last three years are given at Annexure.
