ADVANCE IRRIGATION SYSTEM IN RAJASTHAN

347. SHRI RAJENDRA GEHLOT:

Will the Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the land area covered under the advanced irrigation system in Rajasthan and the number of beneficiaries thereof, so far, district-wise;
- (b) whether Government has undertaken any study to ascertain the impact of micro irrigation projects on farmers' income, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the total number of farmers who have adopted the micro irrigation projects in the country, State-wise and the total number of micro water harvesting structures constructed in Rajasthan during last three years, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) The Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (DA&FW) is implementing Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) scheme from the year 2015-16 in the Country including Rajasthan. PDMC focuses on enhancing water use efficiency at farm level through Micro Irrigation namely Drip and Sprinkler Irrigation systems. The district wise area covered under Micro Irrigation and number of farmers benefited so far under PDMC in the State of Rajasthan is at Annexure-I.
- (b) Evaluation of the PDMC Scheme was taken up by the NITI Aayog during 2020-21. According to the study report:
 - The scheme is relevant in achieving national priorities such as substantially improving on-farm water use efficiency, enhancing crop productivity, generating employment opportunities etc.
 - The scheme has been quite effective in terms of showing benefits (e.g. increase in productivity, reduction in fertilizer consumption, water consumption, power consumption etc.)
 - Impact of this scheme has realized in terms of increase in farmer's income, employment generation and water saving.

- Income of farmers has increased in the range of 10% to 69%.
- Water use efficiency has improved in the range of 30% to 70%.
- c) The State wise total number of farmers who have adopted the micro irrigation in the country under PDMC during last three years is given at Annexure-II. As per the report available from State of Rajasthan, the details of number of micro water harvesting structures (WHS) constructed in State during the last three years are as under:
